

Site Visit – Marathon Palladium Project

The Joint Review Panel (the Panel) for the proposed Marathon Palladium Project is planning to conduct a site visit of the project site and surrounding area in September 2021.

The objective of the site visit is to provide members of the Panel and the Panel Secretariat an opportunity to view the project site, mine site features and their relative locations and the surrounding area and topography. The site visit will include an aerial tour and a ground tour. The former Joint Review Panel Site Visit Summary ([CIAR #197](#)) will be used as the basis for the Panel's itinerary.

Information on additional areas or features to view during the site visit should be submitted to the Panel by **September 10, 2021**. All comments received will be considered public and will be made available on the public registry at <https://www.iaac-aeic.gc.ca/050/evaluations/proj/54755>. If parties have concerns regarding the disclosure of the specific location of a suggested area or feature due to its sensitive nature (i.e. due to cultural considerations, conservation concerns, etc.), the specific location should not be included in your submission. In such circumstances, the Panel Secretariat will contact you directly to obtain the required information.

The Panel and its secretariat will be conducting the site visit on its own and will not be meeting with the proponent, Generation PGM Inc., or any other participant involved in the review. The Panel has developed a safety protocol to ensure the health and safety of the Panel and the Panel Secretariat ([CIAR #918](#)).
